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COMPREHENSIVE OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Bacharach's pediatric rehabilitation service is focused on outpatient care, in the following areas of specialty:

- Cerebral palsy
- Amputees
- Orthopedics
- Down syndrome
- Seizure disorder

CUSTOMIZED CARE

The child's care is planned according to needs and age. The care plan for every child is customized, with these common guidelines:

- Individualized evaluation
- Implementation of an individualized therapy program
- Ongoing communication with family, physicians and school
- Continual assessment during the course of therapy
- Therapy designed to ensure superior, timely outcomes

INTERDISCIPLINARY PLANNING

Bacharach's team of specialists includes physical therapy, occupational therapy, audiology and speech therapy.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

The occupational therapy team specializes in basic activities of daily living, fine motor skills and other upper body rehabilitation, including:

- Sensory integration—teaches the child to balance sensory input
- Neurodevelopmental treatment techniques—to normalize posture and function
- Vision and perception training—with referrals to neuro-optometrist as needed
- Fine motor skills to support activities of daily living
- Parent and family education
- Behavior modification

SPEECH-LANGUAGE THERAPY

Speech-language therapy is critical to the child's ability to communicate, which has significant impact on social and educational well-being.

- Oral motor therapy
- Articulation and phonological therapy
- Language therapy
- Picture Exchange Communication System
- Respiratory and feeding therapy

PHYSICAL THERAPY

Physical therapy for children is focused on gross motor skills. Using a custom plan of assessment and exercise, Bacharach's physical therapists will utilize:

- Range of motion
- Strengthening balance and coordination
- Functional mobility
- Ambulatory training
- Aquatic therapy
- Neuro-developmental techniques
- Functional electrical stimulation
- Orthotics and prosthetics

Additionally, Bacharach offers a monthly spasticity clinic and wheelchair seating clinic.

AUDIOLOGY

Bacharach's audiologists have special training in evaluation and treatment of pediatric hearing disorders.

- Comprehensive evaluation for newborns and older children
- Auditory and brainstem-evoked response testing
- Otoacoustic emissions testing
- Auditory processing evaluations
- Pediatric hearing aid consultation and fitting
